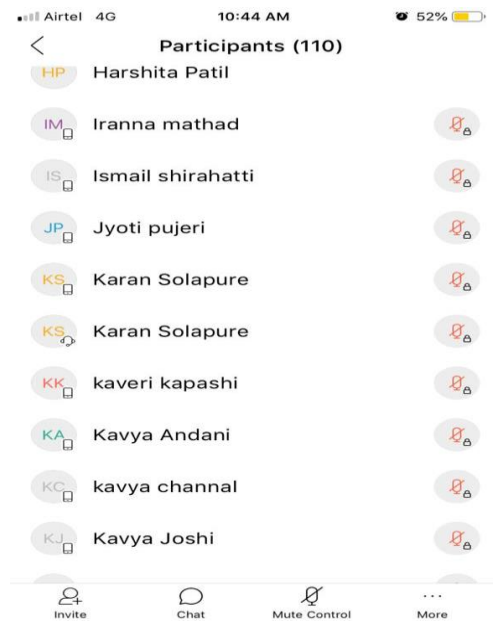
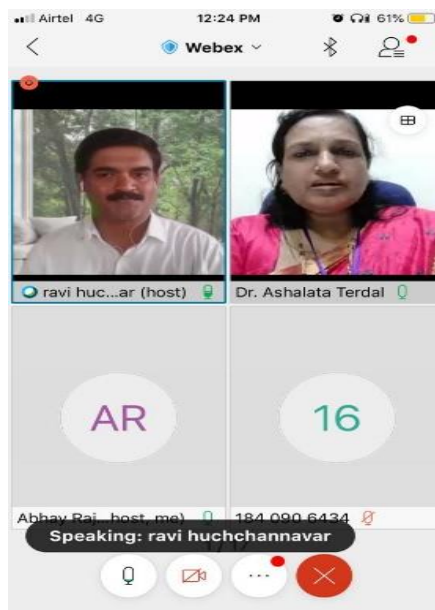
**Objective of the Workshop:**
